After six years, Ryan became the Executive Director of a nonprofit anti-human trafficking organization where he advised on national initiatives for anti-trafficking legislation and led statewide operations and strategic expansion for anti-trafficking programs. He has since served as the Executive Pastor of Leadership and Development at City Light Church in Chattanooga, TN, and the Executive Pastor of Strategic Development at Change Church in Duluth, GA.

Ryan has served in several collateral capacities, including as an expert advisor to state governments, including an appointment to the Georgia Sexual Assault Response Team State Expert Committee and the Tennessee Human Trafficking Advisory Council. Additionally, he held appointments to the Board of Directors for WTCI-PBS Chattanooga and The Chattanooga Chamber of Commerce. Ryan serves as a co-faculty member at the University at Buffalo in the Leadership Coaching Certification program. He has also been tapped to teach and develop curriculum for leadership development and conflict strategy at colleges and universities such as Oglethorpe University, Wheaton College, and Yale University.
